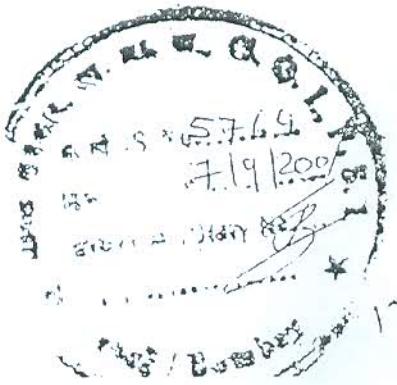
I am directed to refer to your letter No. 3-4/2000-F.I.
