

ONE DAY REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON “MARINE FISHERY RESOURCES OF TAMIL NADU” ORGANISED BY CHENNAI BASE OF FISHERY SURVEY OF INDIA

The Chennai Base of Fishery Survey of India jointly organized one-day regional workshop with Tamilnadu State Fisheries Department on “Marine fishery Resources of Tamil Nadu” on 15.02.2017 at Mahabalipuram, Kanchipuram district.
