

OPEN HOUSE ORGANISHED BY PORT BLAIR BASE OF FISHERY SURVEY OF INDIA

The Port Blair base of Fishery Survey of India has organized an Open house onboard the departmental survey vessel MFV Blue Marlin at Campbell Bay, Great Nicobar on 26th and 27th November 2017. The open-house was organized for the benefit of fisher-folk, students, stakeholders and general public.

The Open-house was inaugurated by the Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Campbell Bay.

Various fishing gears and accessories, navigational, engineering and oceanographic equipments, several aspects on safety at sea and Code of Conduct for Responsible Fisheries were displayed and demonstrated during the occasion.

The Base scientists explained about the Oceanic fishery resources habitat, biology and the mode of exploitation. The Skipper and Bosun briefed the students about the various navigational and fish finding equipments installed onboard the vessel with purpose, functioning and importance of each electronic gadget.
