

## **ONE DAY REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON “MARINE FISHERY RESOURCES OF TAMIL NADU” ORGANISED BY CHENNAI BASE OF FISHERY SURVEY OF INDIA**

The Chennai Base of Fishery Survey of India jointly organized one-day regional workshop with Tamilnadu State Fisheries Department on “Marine fishery Resources of Tamil Nadu” on 03.11.2016 at Community Hall of Pazhaverkadu. The workshop was organized to disseminate the information on survey findings on the resources availability, diversified fishing methods, exploitation of deep sea fishery resources, Code of Conduct for Responsible Fisheries (CCRF) and tuna fishery resources and tuna tagging with visual aids to the representatives of fishermen co-operative societies and near by public.
