

WALK IN INTERVIEW

Qualified and eligible candidates are invited to attend the walk-in-interview for the following posts on 07.02.2022 at 1000 hrs at Fishery Survey of India, Marine Engineering Division, Foreshore Road, Cochin -16, at their own cost, with the application in the prescribed format, original and Xerox copies of certificates including experience certificate.

The appointment will be during sailing period of the vessel (approximately 20 days) in a month or as per the requirement. The validity of the selected panel will be one year or as decided by the competent authority. The details of the posts are given below. Format of application is available at the end of the notification. The walk-in-interview will be conducted as per the Covid protocol of Govt. of Kerala time to time.
