

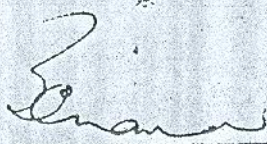

ORDER

The undersigned is directed to convey the approval of the Competent Authority to the delegation of the following powers up to the extent as indicated hereunder to the Director General, Fisheries Survey of India -

4.	Advance payment for purchase of stores from <u>public</u> sector.	Advance payment upto 90% of the cost of stores in each case where the value does not exceed Rs.50,000/-
5.	Printing and binding.	Rs.25,000/- subject to budget provisions and financial procedures.
6.	Local purchase of petty stationery/stores.	Rs.40,000/- per annum.
7.	Permission to deliver lectures and accept examinership by the Scientific Officers/ Technical Officers and to accept remuneration therefor.	Full powers subject to the lectures being delivered within the country and exams held within the country.

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Direct cash purchase of spare parts without inviting quotations in emergency cases, break down of equipment machinery of Fishing Vessels (other than staff car) where in the absence of immediate replacement of spare parts the vessel will be idle and survey work will be hampered.

Maintenance of Residential buildings ordinary repair.

Upto Rs.2,000/- on each occasion subject to the conditions that the purchase is made from the local market through purchase committee.

Rs.10,000/- in each case subject to the work being executed according to the approved estimate of CPWD and annual expenditure not exceeding Rs.2 lakhs under this head of account.

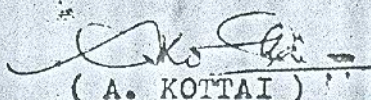

ORDER

Subject: Re-delegation of financial powers to Heads of Fisheries Institutes, namely, Fishery Survey of India, Central Institute of Fisheries Nautical and Engineering Training, Integrated Fisheries Project and Central Institute of Coastal Engineering for Fishery - Reg.

The issue of re-delegation of financial powers to Heads of Departments in the field offices of Fisheries Division in pursuance of the instructions contained in the Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) notification dated 16.9.2003 on Delegation of Financial Powers (Amendment), Rules, 2003 has been under the consideration of this Department for quite some time. In supersession of all the previous orders on the above subject, it has now been decided to delegate financial powers, over and above the floor level delegations given in the Delegation of Financial Powers, Rules, 1978 as amended from time to time (in short referred to as 'DFPR'), to the HODs in respect of contingent expenditure as laid down in Schedule V of DFPR) as per details given below:

With regard to the floor level powers given in the Annexure to Schedule V, it has been decided that the redelegated financial limits (upper) for item-wise expenditures would be as per details given in Annexure L.

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The aforesaid re-delegation of financial powers in the matter of contingent expenditure is subject to the following conditions:

- i) The powers in respect of matters not covered in this order shall be as per the DFPR.
- ii) There is no re-delegation of the powers with reference to writing off losses etc., as laid down in Schedule VII of DFPR.
- iii) The general conditions, rules, orders and especially the restrictions given in the DFPR and the provisions of General Financial Rules, 2005 shall apply in the exercise of powers by the concerned officers. In other words, this order only lays down the upper ceiling limits in respect of financial powers on different subjects/items.
- iv) The powers are subject to economy instructions issued by the Finance Ministry from time to time, Fiscal Codes and procedures and the limits being within the budgetary allocation for the year.
- v) The Heads of Departments have to refer all cases, for which they are not empowered to sanction expenditure as per the aforesaid re-delegations, to this Ministry for approval.

This order comes into immediate effect. It issues with the concurrence of AS&FA vide diary no. 4126 dated 1.3.2007.
