PREFACE

Long term planning of marine fisheries development requires information on social and economical status of fishermen and data on number of fishing villages, landing centre, active fishermen, fishing crafts and gears including the infrastructure facilities in the different Maritime States and Islands. Periodic updating of these data is necessary to monitor the changes caused by the dynamics of techno-socio-economic environment. Census has always been a traditionally accepted method to update the demographic and socio-economic information. Marine Fisheries Census 2010 was undertaken to capture the changes that has occurred in the fisheries sector since the previous census in 2005.

The programme was carried out under the Central Sector Scheme - *Strengthening of Database and Information Networking for the Fisheries Sector* of the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture. The census work of the maritime regions of the mainland was assigned to the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI), Kochi whereas the census of the island territories of Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar was assigned to the Fishery Survey of India (FSI), Mumbai.

Fishery Survey of India conducted Marine Fisheries Census of the Islands during 2005. The second Marine Fisheries Census was conducted during May 2010. This census focused on various characteristic of fisherfolk including their community status, education, occupation, affiliation to co-operatives societies etc. Besides, information on ownership of crafts & gear and infrastructure facilities available in the fishing villages and at the landing centres were also collected.

In order to accomplish the task, two groups of scientific and technical staff of the FSI were deputed to the two island groups. In Lakshadweep Islands, where the FSI did not have a Base Office, the census work was done in consultation with Shri J.K. Dadoo, IAS, Administrator, Dr. M. Koya, Director of Fisheries and Shri V. P. Pradeep Kumar, Secretary, Administration of UT of Lakshadweep. The census was carried out from 2nd to 12th May 2010 by deploying scientific and technical personnel from the FSI Headquarters and Base offices at Mumbai, Kochi, Visakhapatnam and Mormugao. The staff from the Directorate of Fisheries, UT of Lakshadweep Islands also were actively involved. Both the local Administration and the Directorate of Fisheries gave excellent and timely support for the successful completion of the census.

In Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the census was coordinated by Dr L. Ramalingam, Zonal Director of Port Blair Base of FSI, and Dr. V. Krishnamurthy, Director of Fisheries, Anadaman & Nicobar Islands. The census was carried out during 2nd to 12th May 2010 by deploying scientific and technical personnel from the FSI Headquarters, and Base offices at Visakhapatnam and Chennai. Besides, the staff from the Directorate of Fisheries, UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands also actively participated in the census work.

Eighteen officials from FSI and an equal number of officials from the local administration the island groups had worked as supervisors for the census. One hundred and fifteen enumerators were recruited locally and deployed for the census. Different Schedules and publicity material such as posters were printed in the official languages of the respective Islands.

The information collected is presented in the form of summary data in two parts; the first part deals with Island-wise information and the second part provides the village-wise information. The report also carry an Executive Summary, as well as short description of the scope, coverage and methodology on Marine Fisheries Census 2010. Diagrams, photographs, charts, schedules and instructions used for data collection are also included for making the report complete in all aspects.

It is my pleasure to record my deep sense of appreciation to the entire team of FSI for organizing and conducting the exercise as per the scheduled work plan. I also thank the Administrators and the officials of the Union Territories of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep Islands for providing all support and an enabling environment to carry out the Marine Fisheries Census 2010.

REPORT

Executive summary

Census is systematic procedure for collecting information on a population periodically. Census data provide an instantaneous picture of a community in a geographic area at a given point of time. Census data for different periods can give a clear picture of the change in population characteristics.

Census on marine fisheries provides the necessary data for formulating policies for development, management and conservation of sustainable fishery. Since welfare of the dependent communities is the ultimate objective of any development activity, it is essential to have reliable information on the status of marine fishermen. Details of fishing villages, landing centres, fishermen population, occupation status, active fishermen, fishing craft and gear and other related aspects are major components of the information.

Keeping this in view, the Government of India has been conducting Marine Fisheries Censuses every five years. The Government entrusted the responsibility of conducting Marine Fisheries Census in Union Territories of Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep Islands to Fishery Survey of India (FSI) and that of the maritime mainland to Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI). Marine Fisheries Census 2010 was conducted during May 2010 in the Union Territories of Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep Islands.

Details of the marine fishing villages were obtained from the Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep Administrations for preparing the census frame, coverage and logistics. There was not any change in the variables and census parameters from that of the 2005 census. However, provisions for collecting some additional information on fishermen's perception on fishing ban and climate change was included.

The necessary schedules were designed and approved by the Technical Monitoring Committee set up by Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture. Eighteen officials from FSI and an equal number of officials from the UTs supervised the census operation ensuring proper collection of relevant data by 115 field enumerators, mostly drawn from the fisherman communities from 134 marine fishing villages. The enumerators were trained at the central fisheries office in the respective UTs. After completion of the census, the schedules were sent to FSI (HQ) at Mumbai for processing and preparation of reports. The software required for data analysis was provided by the CMFRI while the output report format was prepared by Statistics Section of FSI (HQ).

Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar

Andaman and Nicobar Islands had a total fisherfolk population of 22,188 belonging to 4,861 households, spread in 134 fishing villages. Women formed 45.81% of the fisherfolk population (sex ratio: 845 females for 1,000 males). About 55.62% of the fisherfolk population (excluding below 5 year of age) were educated at different levels (27.84% of them were educated up to primary level, 25.82% up to higher secondary level and only 1.96% educated above higher secondary level). Of the total fisherfolk population, 6,791 were actively engaged in fishing activities (full time/part time.) and 8,577 were involved in fish related allied activities. Women were mostly engaged in fish marketing, peeling, net making/repairing and mending, fish processing and as labourers.

The fisher families in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands belonged to Hindu (78.05%), Christian (19.91%) and Islam (2.04%). The Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes communities were mostly in Nicobar Group of Islands. Only 10.05% of fisher population had membership in fisheries co-operative societies or other co-operative societies.

There were 3,189 fishing craft in Andaman and Nicobar Islands of which 83.38% were in Andaman. The non-motorized craft in these islands formed 51.33%, mechanized craft 1.91%, inboard motored craft 44.72% and outboard craft 2.04%. The outboard and non-motorized craft were mostly plank built boats, fiber glass boats, dugout canoes and outrigger canoes. The crafts and gear were mostly owned by the fisherfolk. Hook and line (47.53%) was the most popular form of fishing gear followed by gillnets (32.93%). Most of the boats in the islands were having life saving equipments such as life jackets and life saving rings. Few boats had electronic gadgets such as echo-sounder, GPS, sonar, fish finder and radio phone.

Union Territory of Lakshadweep

There are ten inhabited islands in the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. All these islands put together, had a population of 34,811 belonging to 5,338 fisher households. Out of this, 25,765 (74.01%) were adults. Among adults, 13,593 (52.76%) were males and 12,172 (47.24%) females. The entire population was Muslim, categorised as Scheduled Tribes.

Among the island groups, the highest numbers of households was observed in Minicoy Island (921) followed by Androth (727) and the lowest number was in Bitra Island (35). The largest family size (9.15) was in Minicoy followed by Agatti (7.45) and the smallest family size of 3.73 was in Chetlat Island. The average family size in Lakshadweep was 6.52. In this UT, 24,533 (77.02%) of the fisherfolk population (excluding below 5 year of age) was educated, 25.57% of them were educated up to primary level, 42.06% up to higher secondary level and 9.40% above higher secondary level.

Fishing activity was the occupation of 16.29% of the fisher population and 15.54% were engaged in fishing associated activities. Out of 5,669 fishermen involved in fishing, 38.56% were engaged in fulltime fishing and 61.44% in part time fishing. Women mostly were engaged in fish curing/ processing, fish marketing, net making/repairing and as labourers. A total of 5,086 persons had membership either in fisheries co-operatives or in other co-operatives. The membership in fisheries co-operatives was a mere 2.3%.

There were 1,462 fishing craft in Lakshadweep. Out of these, 129 (8.82%) were mechanized, 366 (25.03%) inboard motored, 240 (16.42%) outboard motored and 727 (49.73%) non-motorized. Among these craft, pole and line boats, plank-built boats, gill netters, liners and catamaran were dominant. The most popular gears in Lakshadweep were hook & line, pole & line, gillnets, troll line, shore seines and traps. The most popular fishing methods are hook & line and pole & line.

About the Census

Introduction

Recognizing the need for formulating policies for development, conservation, management, sustainable use of fishery resources, the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India has drawn up a scheme during the X Five Year Plan for Strengthening of Database and Geographical Information System for the Indian fishery sector. Availability of reliable and up-to-date data is essential for evolving appropriate policies and for fisheries management. A national level census on important attributes of marine fisheries has been envisaged as a precursor to developing a national database. The national level review committee constituted by the Ministry underscored the importance of carrying out a census of fishermen population, their occupation status, fishing craft and gears and perception of fishermen on fishing ban, pollution, over-fishing, juvenile exploitation, climate change and other related matters.

The marine fisheries census also is useful for developing frame and sample design in connection with sample surveys for data collection programme and statistical investigations. These efforts are required for estimation of marine fish landing and fish stock assessment in different regions of the country. The census data are indispensable for social and economic development planning. The data on educational levels of the individuals are very important for manpower planning. Besides, the census data can prove very useful in the formulation of policies on education, health, agriculture and food etc.

The Fishery Survey of India is mandated for survey and assessment of fish stocks and charting of fishing grounds in the Indian EEZ and adjoining high seas, assessment of suitability of deep-sea fishing gear, marine fisheries forecasting, maintaining data on deepsea fishery resources and dissemination of information etc. FSI was recognized as one of the agencies for the national level Marine Fishery Census. The Institute was given the task of conducting the census in the Union Territories of Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep Islands. The CMFRI was assigned the task of conducting the census in the coastal states in the mainland. The census in the island territories was conducted in synchronization with the census in the mainland during May 2010.

Scope

The marine fisheries census, as ordained in the present venture, had to focus on the coastal population whose livelihood is entwined with fishing related activities. Like any census, an unambiguous definition of the target population is an important precursor. As the census had been aimed to aid planning and policy making in the fishery sector, the beneficiaries of various programmes and targeted community had to be clearly defined. Taking these in to account, the census operation had adopted a twin strategy, one to cover the fishermen who make living out of this profession and the other on the assets and endowment of the community.

This report focuses on the physical status of the fishery inventory while making a conscious attempt to avoid inquiry about the economic status of the fisherfolk. The report

also focuses on the assorted information including gadgets for communication and life saving equipments.

Objectives

The following are the objective of the census:

- ☒ Determine population size and structure of fisherfolk on a micro level.
- ☒ Assess the educational, occupational and socio-religious status of fisherfolk.
- ☒ Determine the members of active fishermen engaged in fishing.
- ☒ Determine gender-wise occupation in fishery related activities.
- ☒ Quantify the number of craft and gear.
- ☒ Determine the number of craft and gear owned by fisherfolk.
- ☒ Obtain information on infrastructure facilities in villages and landing centres.
- ☒ Obtain information on other facilities and social aspects.

Reference date

The reference date of Census in Andaman and Nicobar and Lakshadweep Group of Islands shall be taken as 2nd May 2010.

Methodology


Conducting a census involves a number of meticulous statistical processes. One must begin with a quality survey frame in which errors due to under-coverage, mis-classification and duplication are minimized. Before commencement of the census, the list of marine fishing villages available with FSI was validated with the latest data obtained from the Union Territories concerned. The coordinators were then instructed to further verify and validate the list of marine fishing villages through field visits, to ascertain whether the listed villages fall under the purview of marine fisheries census.

The census data were collected on two levels, one on a micro level covering individual households in each fishing village. These data were collected by field level enumerators. The enumerators were deputed to all identified fisher households in the coverage area and detailed information was recorded in the enumeration schedules. Complete enumeration by the interviewing method was applied. In the second level, data were collected on a village level on the infrastructure facilities. This was carried out by the field level supervisors from the FSI.

It is understandable that in this census, where the education and social status of the target population is not high, there are bound to be certain amount of non-sampling errors, or response error which could be due to unwillingness to report correctly for a number of reasons. Every effort was made to reduce such errors. This was achieved by recruiting the enumerators from the fisher communities and mostly from the same island / villages that were being enumerated. As the enumerators were from the same locality and better acquainted with the local conditions, it is expected that errors could be minimal.

Organization

The census organization is structured as follows :



The census operation was supervised by around 18 personnel of FSI from Mumbai, Mormugao, Visakhapatnam, Chennai, Kochi and Port Blair Bases and the FSI Headquarters. The overall co-ordination for Andaman & Nicobar Island and Lakshadweep Islands was vested with Director General, Fishery Survey of India who was assisted by Shri P. C. Rao, Statistician, Shri B. M. Raut and Shri Ashish Kumar, Data Processing Assistants. Statistics section of FSI was responsible for printing of schedules for data collection, data processing and printing the census report.

Definitions

1. *House-hold* : A household consists of a person or a group of persons who live together in the same house, share the same house-keeping arrangements and are catered for as one. It is important to remember that members of a household are not necessarily related (by blood or marriage) as, for instance, maidservants may form part of household. On the other hand, not all those related in the same house are necessarily members of the same household, two brothers who live in the same house with their wives and children may or may not form separate households depending their catering arrangements. Thus, in many cases, a house may be broken into separate households (families).
2. *Marine fisherman* : A person who is engaged in marine fishing or any other fishing associated activity or both (A person here means a man or a woman).
3. *Marine fishing village* : An assemblage of houses / dwelling place where marine fishermen live.
4. *Fish landing centre* : The place or harbour where fishermen land their craft with catch.
5. *Fishermen family* : A family in which at least one member is engaged in marine fishing or associated activities or both.

Family size

1. *Adult* : Adult refers to a person who has attained the age of 15 and above.
2. *Children* : Those who are below 15 years of age.

Occupation

1. *Actual fishing* : A fisherman engaged in fishing (Fishing includes seed collection also in this context) can be included in any one of the three categories, viz. full time or part-time or occasional.
2. *Full-time* : A fisherman who spends at least 90% of his working time for fishing.
3. *Part-time* : A fisherman who spends at least 30% of his working time, but less than 90% of his time in fishing.
4. *Occasional* : Includes those who spend less than 30% of their time in fishing.

Education

1. *Primary* includes those who studied upto Vth standard of schooling.
2. *Secondary* refers to those who have studied upto Xth standard.
3. *Above Secondary* refers to those who have continued their education above secondary.

Design of schedules

Three types of schedules designed by the CMFRI were used to collect information at the field level; one, for the house-hold information second for village-level infrastructure facilities and third for fishing craft, fishing harbour/landing centre including registration of boats and facility available in harbour. The household schedule contains 308 columns intended to cover population size with details on male, female, adult and children in each family, their social and educational status, their involvement in co-operatives together with occupation in the fishing and related activities etc.

Training of Supervisors

The officers of FSI, participated in the training programmes organized by the CMFRI at Mumbai, Chennai, Cochin and Visakhapatnam. The various items of Schedule I, Schedule II and Schedule III were thoroughly discussed.

Appointment and training of enumerators

In consultation with the Director of Fisheries, Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep Administrations for the conduct of the census 75 enumerators were appointed in Andaman & Nicobar Islands and 40 in Lakshadweep Islands. The enumerators (with education level of higher secondary or above) were drawn from the fishing communities and mostly from the Islands and fishing villages concerned. They were trained by the field level supervisors to collect household information, prior to the actual census operation, and thereafter, field level collection of various items of Schedule I commenced on a trial basis. On validation and making necessary corrections, the actual census operation was started.

Instructions

Exhaustive instructions in the vernacular on how to collect and fill up all the columns were prepared and distributed to the enumerators.

Publicity and media coverage

Publicity materials in Hindi and English were distributed through posters and other handouts. The print and visual media (Akashwani and Doordarshan) extended wide coverage for the census programme.

Launching of Census operation

The Marine Fisheries Census in Andaman & Nicobar Group of Islands was formally launched on 1st May 2010 at the Conference Hall of Port Blair Base of Fishery Survey of India. Shri M. Johny, Assistant Director, Department of Fisheries, Andaman & Nicobar Administration inaugurated the census. He assured his full support to the activity and opined that census results will update the information on the fisheries establishment, infrastructure. The census in the Lakshadweep Group of Islands was launched on 2nd May 2010.

Data entry, validation, processing and report generation

After completion of census work in different islands, the data schedules were sent to FSI headquarters at Mumbai. Software for data entry was provided by the CMFRI while the output format for data processing and report generation was prepared by Statistics Section FSI (HQ). Database (MS-ACCESS) for each Union Territory was created. Data entry work was done by Data Processing Assistants, Data Entry Operators and Research Fellows. After completion of data entry, the validation checks were run for each database. Reports in the form of different tables covering each of the census items aggregated over island / village level were prepared. Summary of various parameters of the census in Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep Island are presented in the ensuing sections.

Summary of findings

1. Andaman and Nicobar Islands

1.1 Fishing Villages and Population

- a. In Andaman and Nicobar Islands, there are 134 fishing villages and the total fisherfolk population is 22,188 living in 4,861 families (Table-1.1.1, Fig.1.1, Fig.1.2).
- b. Maximum numbers of fishing villages (96) are in Andaman Islands.
- c. About 81.33% of the total fisherfolk population, inhabit in Andaman Islands and 18.67% in Nicobar Islands (Table-1.1.1, Table-1.1.2, Fig.1.2).
- d. Diglipur (North & Middle Andaman) had highest number of fishing villages (27) and households (759) whereas Port Blair recorded 18 villages and 1,120 household (Table-1.1.1).
- e. In Nicobar Group of Islands highest number of households are in Car-Nicobar (383) followed by Non Cowry (255) (Table-1.1.1).
- f. Average family size in Andaman and Nicobar Islands is 4.56 with highest average of 5.73 in Rangat and smallest average of 3.90 in Ferrargung (Table-1.1.2, Fig.1.3).
- g. Women formed 45.81% of the population with 845 females for 1,000 males.
- h. Port Blair Taluka (South Andaman) recorded as most fisherfolk population (5,306) followed by Ferrargunj (3,513) (Table-1.1.2)

1.2 Poverty

- a. There were 1,243 fisherfolk households below poverty line (Table-1.1.1).
- b. The largest number of households below poverty line was found in Ferrargunj (29.93%) followed by Car Nicobar (17.22%), Great Nicobar(17.22%) and Little Andaman (11.75%).

1.3 Education

- a. About 55.62% of fisherfolk population (excluding children below 5 yrs. of age) in Andaman and Nicobar Islands are educated at different levels (Table-1.1.3, Fig.1.4).
- b. Among the educated fisherfolk (11,125), about 50.05% of populations are educated upto primary level, 46.42% upto higher secondary level and 3.53% above higher secondary level.
- c. Highest number of educated fishers occurred in Port Blair (28.74%) followed by Ferrargunj (22.96%).

1.4 Occupation

- a. Nearly 75.32% of the fisherfolk were engaged full time and 24.68% part time in fishing (Table-1.1.4, Fig. 1.6, 1.7).
- b. About 69.26% of the population are engaged in fishing and allied activities (Table-1.1.5).
- c. There are 6,791 fisherfolk engaged in actual fishing activities and 8,557 fisherfolk involved in fish related activities (Table-1.1.5).
- d. About 38.66 % of fisherfolk are involved in fishing related activities (Table-1.1.5, Fig.1.8).
- e. Fishing related activities are predominantly undertaken by men (75.54%) (Table-1.1.6).
- f. Most preferred fishing related activity is fish marketing and net making/repairing

- g. Women, besides fish marketing, also do net making, mending, fish processing, peeling and labour works (Table-1.1.6).

1.5 Religion

- a. Among the fisherfolk of Andaman and Nicobar, Hinduism (78.05%) is the most practiced religion followed by Christianity (19.91%) and Islam (2.04%) (Table-1.1.7).
- b. Scheduled Caste and Tribes formed 13.99% of total fisherfolk. Of these, 98.53% inhabits in Nicobar Islands and remaining 1.47% in Andaman Islands.

1.6 Membership of Co-operative Societies

- a. Only 10.05% of fisherfolk population is having membership either in Fisheries Co-operatives or other Co-operative Societies (Table- 1.1.8).
- b. Only 8.81% are members of Fisheries Co-operative Societies.
- c. Maximum members of Fisheries Co-operative Societies are found in Rangat, Port Blair, Diglipur and Mayabandar.

1.7 Craft

The details of different types of craft each in the categories of mechanized, motorized and non-motorized are collected at two levels. District-wise fleet strength collected by the field level supervisors from village records as well as by actual count is given in Table-1.1.9, Fig.1.10. The information on craft owned / shared by the fisherfolk collected from the individual household survey as per the Schedule-I is given in Table-1.1.10, Fig. 1.11.

- ☞ There are 3,189 fishing craft in Andaman and Nicobar Group of Islands of which 2,659 are in Andaman and 530 in Nicobar (Table-1.1.9, Fig.1.10).
- ☞ There are 61 mechanized craft mainly consisting of gill netters.
- ☞ The inboard motored craft (1,426) are deployed for gillnetting or lining.
- ☞ The non-motorized craft (1,637) are plank-built boats, outrigger canoes, dugout canoes, catamarans, ferro cement boats and masula boats.
- ☞ In Andaman and Nicobar Islands, 82.93% of the total craft (Excluding Non-motorized crafts) are owned by fisherfolk and the rest is shared (Table-1.1.10, Table-1.1.11, Fig.1.11).
- ☞ In Andaman 80.96% of the total craft (Excluding non-motorized boat) are owned by fisherfolk whereas in Nicobar 93.44% of the total craft owned by fisherfolk

1.8 Fishing Gear

- Hook & line and gillnet are the main fishing gears in Andaman and Nicobar Group of Islands. Hook & line (Table-1.1.12) forms 47.53% of the total gears followed by gillnet (32.93%) and cast net (14.06%). The other fishing gears used in the Island are troll lines (3.83%) and trawl net (0.76%). District-wise, South Andaman has 53.46% of the total gears. (Fig.1.12 to Fig.1.14).

1.9 Infrastructure facilities

About 98 villages in Andaman and Nicobar Islands are connected by road and 101 villages are having electricity. Out of 164 hospitals / dispensaries, 121 are in Andaman and 43 in Nicobar. Banking and bus facilities are available in most of the islands. Most of the villages are having community centres (Table-1.1.13).

The fishermen population mainly lives in *kutcha* houses (52%). Almost all the islands have primary and secondary schools. However, colleges and technical institutes are available in Port Blair and Mayabandar (Table-1.1.14).

There are five boat building yards in Little Andaman. Other fishery related infrastructure includes six ice factories, six cold storages and two freezing plants, all in Andaman Islands. (Table-1.1.15)

1.10 Other information

- ☞ Some of the fishing craft in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands have electronic gadgets such as echo-sounder, GPS, mobile phone, radio phone and sonar fish finder (Table-1.1.16).
- ☞ 16 families in Andaman Islands having GPS, 186 families radio phone and only 1 family have sonar fish finder equipments.
- ☞ In Andaman 2195 families are having life saving equipments whereas in Nicobar Islands, 444 families possess life saving equipments.
- ☞ In Andaman and Nicobar Islands, 863 family are using mobile phone.

2. Lakshadweep Islands

2.1 Fishing Villages and Population

- ☞ In Lakshadweep there are ten inhabited Islands and the total fisherfolk population is 34,811 living in 5,338 families (Table-1.2.1, Fig.2.1).
- ☞ The highest number of 921 households are in Minicoy with a population of 8,426 and lowest number of 35 households are in Bitra with a population of 154.
- ☞ The average family size is 6.52 with largest size of 9.15 in Minicoy and smallest size of 3.73 in Chetlat (Table-1.2.2, Fig. 2.2).
- ☞ Women formed 47.60 % of the total fisherfolk population with 908 females for 1,000 males (Table-1.2.2).

2.2. Poverty

- ☞ There were 1,872 fisherfolk households below poverty line (Table-1.2.1)
- ☞ The highest number of households below poverty line was found in Kalpeni (18.32%) followed by Chetlat (17.25%) and Kiltan (15%).

2.3. Education

- ☞ About 77.02% of fisherfolk population (excluding children below 5 yrs. of age) in Lakshadweep Islands are educated at different levels (Table-1.2.3, Fig.2.3)
- ☞ Among the educated fisherfolk (24,533), 33.20% are educated upto primary level, 54.60% to higher secondary level and 12.20% above higher secondary level.
- ☞ Highest number of educated fishers were in Minicoy (28.66%) followed by Androth (14.03%).

2.4. Occupation

- ☞ About 5,669 fisherfolk, which formed 16.29% of total population, are engaged in fishing activities (Table-1.2.4, Fig.2.4 and Fig.2.5).
- ☞ Among active fishermen, 38.56 are full time fishermen and 61.44% are part time fishermen (Fig.2.5).
- ☞ 15.54% of population was engaged in fishing associated activities (Table-1.2.5, Fig.2.7 and Fig.2.8).
- ☞ The percentage male and female population involved in the fishing associated activities was 51.93% and 48.07% respectively (Table-1.2.6).
- ☞ Most prominent fishing related activity among males is marketing of fish (36.38%) and among women is curing/fish processing (69.58%) (Table-1.2.6).

2.5. Religion

- ☞ The entire fisherfolk of the island territory are practicing Islam (Table-1.2.7).
- ☞ The population in the entire island territory belongs to Scheduled Tribe.

2.6. Membership of Cooperative Societies

- ☞ 14.61% of fisherfolk are having membership in cooperatives (Table-1.2.8).
- ☞ Among the members, only 2.3% are members in fisheries cooperatives.

2.7 Craft

- ☞ There are 1,462 fishing craft in Lakshadweep (Table-1.2.9, Fig.2.9).
- ☞ There are 129 mechanized, 366 inboard motored, 240 outboard motored and 727 non-motorised crafts.
- ☞ Non-motorised craft formed 49.73% of the fleet.
- ☞ Maximum number of owned craft (Excluding Non-motorized crafts) are in Minicoy Island (80) followed by Kiltan island (78).
- ☞ Agatti Island had the maximum number of inboard craft (95 Nos.) and Kalpeni Island had the maximum number of mechanized craft (40 Nos.)

2.8 Fishing Gear

- ☞ The most popular gear in Lakshadweep are hook & line, pole & line, troll line, gill nets, cast net, shore seines and boat seine (Table-1.2.12).
- ☞ Hook & line (45.59%), pole & line (19.10%), troll line(18.45%) and gillnets comprise 2.59% of the gear owned by fisherfolk (Table-1.2.13).
- ☞ Sharing pattern is observed mainly in pole & line, hook & line and troll line, cast net and gill net (Table-1.2.14).

2.9 Infrastructure facilities

- ☞ All the villages are electrified and provided with medical facilities (Table-1.2.15).
- ☞ Except Bitra island, all islands are having bank facilities.
- ☞ In all the islands, over 88% of fisherfolk reside in *Pucca* houses (Table-1.2.16).
- ☞ The Union Territory has 3 technical institutes, 7 colleges, 14 secondary schools and 36 primary schools.
- ☞ There are three boat building yards, one each in Agatti, Chetlat and Kavaratti (Table-1.2.17).
- ☞ There are three ice factories, one each at Agatti, Amini and Kavaratti.
- ☞ Cold storage facilities are available in 5 islands.
- ☞ The only one freezing plant is located in Chetlat.

2.10 Other information


- ☞ In Lakshadweep, 359 families are using GPS facilities while in entire island group, 15 families of Kadmat Island are using radio phone facility (Table-1.2.18).
- ☞ In Lakshadweep, 651 families are having life saving equipments.
- ☞ Agatti have more number of GPS (235) but in Bitra, Chetlat and Kadmat island no one uses it.
- ☞ Agatti have maximum number of life saving equipment (179) followed by Chetlat (88).
- ☞ About 1,338 families are using mobile phone.






Fig. 1.2 : Marine fisherfolk households & population




Fig. 1.3 : Average family size




Fig. 1.4 : Educational status of fisherfolk




Fig. 1.5 : Occupational status of fisherfolk




Fig. 1.6 : Active fishermen




Fig. 1.7 : Fishermen involved in actual fishing




Fig. 1.8 : Distribution of fishing allied activities




Fig. 1.9 : Occupational profile

Fig. 1.9.1 : Marketing of fish




Fig. 1.9.2 : Making / Repairing net




Fig. 1.9.3 : Curing / Processing




Fig. 1.9.4 : Peeling




Fig. 1.10 : Total fishing craft in the fishery




Fig. 1.11 : Craft owned by fisherfolk




Fig. 1.12 : Gillnets owned by fisherfolk




Fig. 1.13 : Hooks & line gear owned by fisherfolk





Fig. 1.14 : Castnet gear owned by fisherfolk





Fig. 2.1 : Marine fisherfolk households & population




Fig. 2.2 : Average family size




Fig. 2.3 : Educational status of fisherfolk




Fig. 2.4 : Occupation status of fisherfolk in Lakshadweep Islands




Fig. 2.5 : Active fishermen




Fig. 2.6 : Fishermen involved in actual fishing




Fig. 2.7 : Distribution of fishing allied activities




Fig. 2.8 : Occupational profile




Fig. 2.8.2 : Making / Repairing net




Fig. 2.8.3 : Curing / Processing




Fig. 2.8.4 : Peeling




Fig. 2.9 : Total fishing craft in the fishery




Fig. 2.10 : Craft owned by fisherfolk




Fig. 2.11 : Mechanised craft owned by fisherfolk




Fig. 2.12 : Pole & line gear owned by fisherfolk




Fig. 2.13 : Seine-nets owned by fisherfolk




Fig. 2.14 : Drift-nets owned by fisherfolk




Fig. 2.15 : Troll-lines owned by fisherfolk




Fig. 2.16 : Gillnets owned by fisherfolk




Fig. 2.17 : Hooks & lines gear owned by fisherfolk





Fig. 2.18 : Castnet gear owned by fisherfolk




