

I. FROM THE RESEARCH FRONT

Distribution of longnose lancetfish, $Alepisaurus\ ferox$ in the Indian EEZ

Survey conducted by the FSI longline vessels in the Indian EEZ revealed that, longnose lancetfish, *Alepisaurus ferox* Lowe, 1833 is caught from areas south of latitude 17°'N of the Arabian Sea, from most of the Bay of Bengal and Andaman and Nicobar waters. The distribution of this species is probably controlled by the oceanic currents as well as oxygen and salinity regimes in the waters around Indian peninsula.

II. OUTREACH AND TRAINING

III. ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

Degree awarded

Shri Sijo P. Varghese, Senior Scientific Assistant, FSI, HQ Mumbai was awarded the Ph. D Degree on 9 September 2010 by the University of Mumbai for his thesis entitled Trophic Ecology of Large Predatory Fishes in West Coast of Indian EEZ. Shri Varghese worked under the guidance of

Dr. V. S. Somvanshi, the former Director General of FSI. He studied the diet composition, consumption rates, trophic levels and feeding partitioning among the tunas, bill fishes, sharks, rays and other large predators of Arabian Sea shedding light to the hitherto unknown oceanic food web of the area.

IV. HALF YEARLY REVIEW OF OPERATIONAL AND SCIENTIFIC ACTIVITIES OF FSI

The half yearly meeting for reviewing the operational and scientific activities of FSI was held at the Chennai Base of FSI during 17-18 September 2010. The Officers-in-charge and Engineers from all the Bases participated in the meeting. Dr K. Vijayakumaran, Director General, Chaired the meeting. He welcomed the participants and briefed about the outlook of resources survey programmes and appealed for concerted efforts from the Bases for more scientific contributions.

He informed that, scientists from FSI were trained on data analysis, writing and publication of scientific paper/popular articles in reputed peer reviewed journals in the recently organized training workshop on *Scientific Methods* and *Writing* at Kochi. The Chairman advised the Base officers to submit necessary proposals for specific training programmes for the employees of the Institute as a part of capacity building and also added that the FSI would collaborate with various organizations like CMFRI, CIFT and NFDB etc for successful implementation of scientific projects and capacity building programmes. The Chairman emphasised the need for adopting *positive thinking for achieving the mission*.

The Dy. Director General (Fy) subsequently initiated the scientific review. The qualitative and quantitative performance of the survey vessels were reviewed based on the the fishery resources survey programme 2010. Base officers were asked to attend to the critical issues like echo-sounder fitting, sanctioning HSD oil, deviation in survey programme, decommissioning of *Matsya Sugundhi*, berthing problem at Mormugao, non-participation of scientist on board etc. Biological studies undertaken by different Bases were also reviewed and reminded the scientists about the importance of collecting such data which are crucial for the management of fishery resources. Followed by this, discussion were held on maintenance of survey fleet, matters relating to office administration and accounts.
